Our Mission: To strengthen families through the parenting experience, by supporting and empowering mothers during pregnancy. To provide pregnancy and labor support as well as prenatal education in a supportive, non-judgmental community for at-risk pregnant women who desire our services, regardless of age or culture.



We celebrated our 6-year anniversary. In November we moved to our new space in NE Minneapolis. We are now able to offer so much more to the families we serve.

Some of our 2009 accomplishments....

- We were able to increase the number of women who were provided with doula services by 18.5% from 2008.
- Increased the number of doulas to 31, speaking 12 languages (Arabic, Spanish, English, French, Farsi, German, Ebonics, Somali, Luganda, Hmong, Hebrew and American Sign).
 - Expanded our car seat program by 52% and contracted with Medica to provide car seats to their members.
 - EM Doulas attended a two day on working with women who have suffered abuse.
 - Increased revenues by 53.2%
 - Began offering prenatal yoga in our new space along with group Childbirth education and car seat clinics.

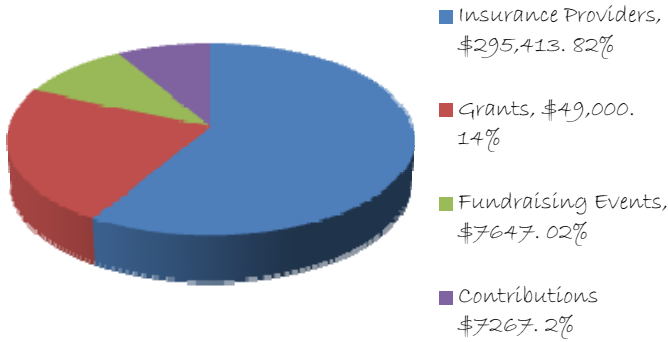

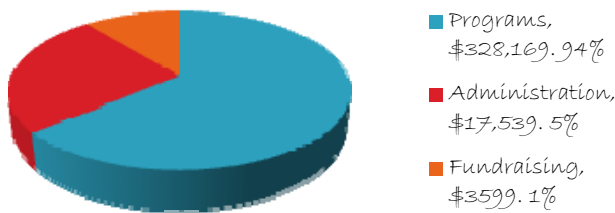
