We celebrated our 7-year anniversary. We've had one year at our new space and are bursting at the seams!

Some of our 2010 accomplishments....

- We were able to increase the number of women who were provided with doula services by 14.25% from 2009.
- Increased our revenue by 26%
 - Began attending births with inmates at the Shakopee Prison
 - Completed one year of education classes at Shakopee Prison
 - We filled the place to the rafters at our Open House in February
 - Hosted a belly casting party. Mom's went home with a belly and we decorated the space!
 - Doula took a special training on working with Mom's from the Methadone Clinic.

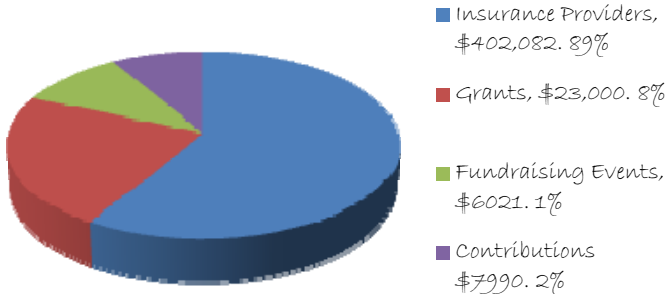

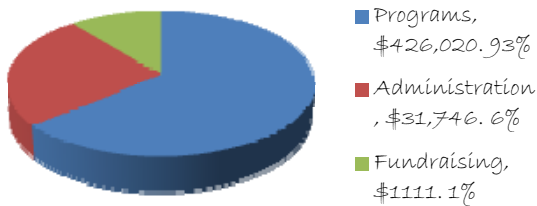
